Maria is also an authorized *Muller*-technique pedagogue and teaches professionals all around the globe, as well as the CEO of *Miscellaneous AB* where art is combined with digital technology.

Choreographer and performer Maria Naidu strives to make high-quality dancework available and accessible to a diverse audience from all over the world. Her main tool is movement, and her choreography is further characterized by a textural diversity and theatrical details.
